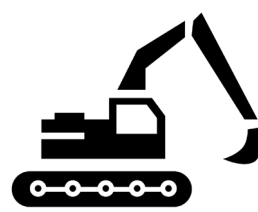

Mission Areas

Innovative Enduring Sustainable Engineering Solutions



CIVIL WORKS

Studies, designs and builds projects to reduce risk to human life, reduce flood damages, restore infrastructure and ecosystems, improve watersheds and maintain navigation by partnering with tribal, state, and local governments and agencies.



Recreation

Manages 102 recreation areas at 10 water resource projects in the valleys of California from Black Butte Lake in the north to Success Lake in the south.



Dam Operations & Maintenance

Owns, operates, and maintains 17 dams in California's Central Valley, and prescribes rules and regulations for flood control operations at 31 dams owned by other agencies.



Levee Safety

Oversees maintenance of approx. 1,600 miles of levees across CA, NV, UT, and CO.



Emergency Operations

Responds to disasters and emergencies, provides engineering expertise, debris management, infrastructure assessments, and more.



Regulatory

Protecting the Nation's aquatic resources and navigation capacity, while allowing reasonable development through fair and balanced permit decisions. Evaluates applications for construction activities occurring in the Nation's waters, including wetlands.



Environment

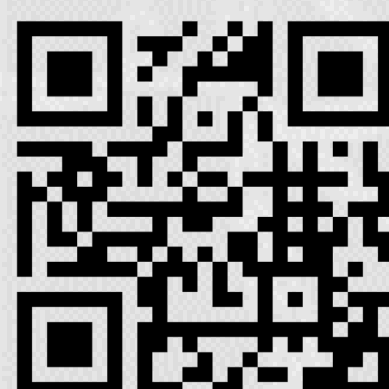
Ecosystem restoration, wetlands restoration, and conservation projects that improve wildlife habitat.
