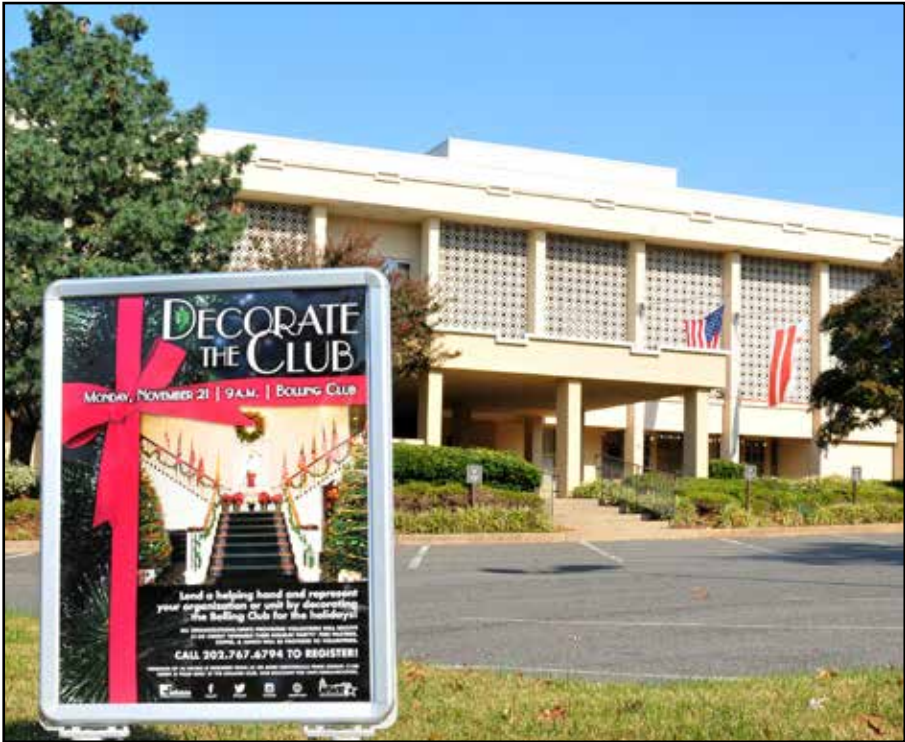
Planning to send some holiday cheer to your loved ones serving overseas before Dec. 25? The U.S. Postal Service advises that you get a head start on your mailing or shipping needs sooner than later.

The post office on Joint Base Anacostia-Bolling is open weekdays from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. and 3 p.m. to 5 p.m. On weekends, it's open on Saturday from 9 a.m. to noon and closed Sunday.

The Postal Service recommends cards and packages going to military APO/FPO/DPO addresses overseas are sent no later than the mailing dates listed below:
