


Army ACE Suicide Intervention Program

The Army ACE Suicide Intervention (ACE-SI) Program is a three-hour training that provides Soldiers with the awareness, knowledge, and skills necessary to intervene with those at risk for suicide. ACE stands for Ask, Care, and Escort. The purpose of ACE is to help Soldiers and junior leaders become more aware of steps they can take to prevent suicides and confident in their ability to do so. The class must take place in a classroom environment. 
