

## SGLI now found online; no more paper

#### FROM NAVY PERSONNEL **COMMAND PUBLIC AFFAIRS**

**A**ailors and families who log into the Servicemember's Group Life Insurance Online Enrollment System for the first time may be surprised when they see there is no beneficiary information listed.

"Your SGLI coverage is still in place," said Ann Stewart, director, Pay and Personnel Department, Navy Personnel Command. "Sailors who log into SOES for the first time will have to input their beneficiary information manually. That is why there is no infor-




