USAG BENELUX TO CONDUCT FULL-SCALE EXERCISE ON MAY 17

On May 17, the garrison will conduct a full-scale exercise to train and validate the coordinated emergency response plan. After 12 p.m. (noon) that day, customers will have limited access to services and facilities on Chièvres Air Base. We strongly encourage people to plan accordingly and avoid the base, if possible, when the exercise is underway. The following offices and facilities will be closed:
