DIESEL NO LONGER AVAILABLE AT THE SCHINNEN EXCHANGE GAS STATION

As of April 3, diesel fuel is no longer available at the Schinnen Exchange Gas Station. Euro 95 and 98 are still available. The gas station is scheduled to close by the end of the April as the Schinnen site is relocating to Brunssum. The gas station is, however, not relocating to Brunssum.
