



On Veterans Day our Nation honors the great Americans who stood ready to give life itself on behalf of freedom in service to our country. More than 40 percent of the Corps of Engineers' workforce is made up of veterans. Add to them our active duty, those serving in the National Guard and Reserve, and the family members serving or

who served, and we have much to honor this day.

The day chosen – the 11th day of the 11th month – honors the day in 1918 when the Armistice with Germany went into effect. In November 1919, President Wilson proclaimed November 11 as the first commemoration of Armistice Day with the following words:

"To us in America, the reflections of Armistice Day will be filled with solemn pride in the heroism of those who died in the country's service and with gratitude for the victory, both because of the thing from which it has freed us and because of the opportunity it has given America to show her sympathy with peace and justice in the councils of the nations..."

The original concept was a day for parades and public meetings with a brief suspension of business beginning at 11:00 a.m. On May 13, 1938, the 11th of November in each year became a legal holiday – a day dedicated to the cause of world peace and thereafter celebrated and known as "Armistice Day."

It honored World War I veterans, but after World War II required the greatest mobilization of Soldiers, Sailors, Marines and Airmen in the Nation's history and

after American forces fought aggression in Korea, the 83rd Congress, at veterans service organizations urging, amended the Act of 1938 by striking out the word "Armistice" and inserting "Veterans." With the legislation approval June 1, 1954, November 11th became a day to honor American veterans of all wars.

In the Seattle District Honor Book pages, you will see the names and photos of many district and family member veterans. Providing the information was voluntary, so not everyone is included. You'll also see active-duty military, DA civilians who currently serve in uniform in the National Guard or Reserves, and family members serving as well.

I encourage everyone to take this opportunity to get to know each other more closely. I believe understanding or knowing more about each other can only make us a better team than we already are.

I will leave you with this...it is important we honor and thank those who selflessly served our country and risked their lives to protect our freedom. President John F. Kennedy said, "As we express our gratitude, we must never forget that the highest appreciation is not to utter words, but to live by them."

Those in these pages definitely lived by them and continue to do so as members of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, including our family members. Join me in celebrating our Veterans for their legacy of honorable service and dedication to our nation.
