## Hiring Fair held at Riley's Community Center open to all with post access

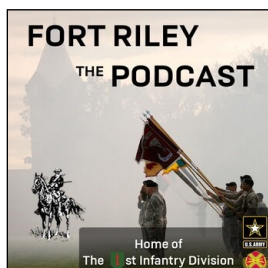
