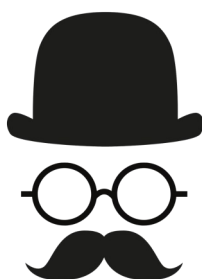
Volunteers, patrons celebrate a year of thrift shop success

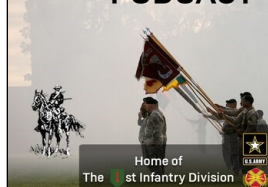


Doc Jargon, cuts through the jargon that is the language of the U.S. Army. This week the Doc explains a little about the organizational structure of Army units.
