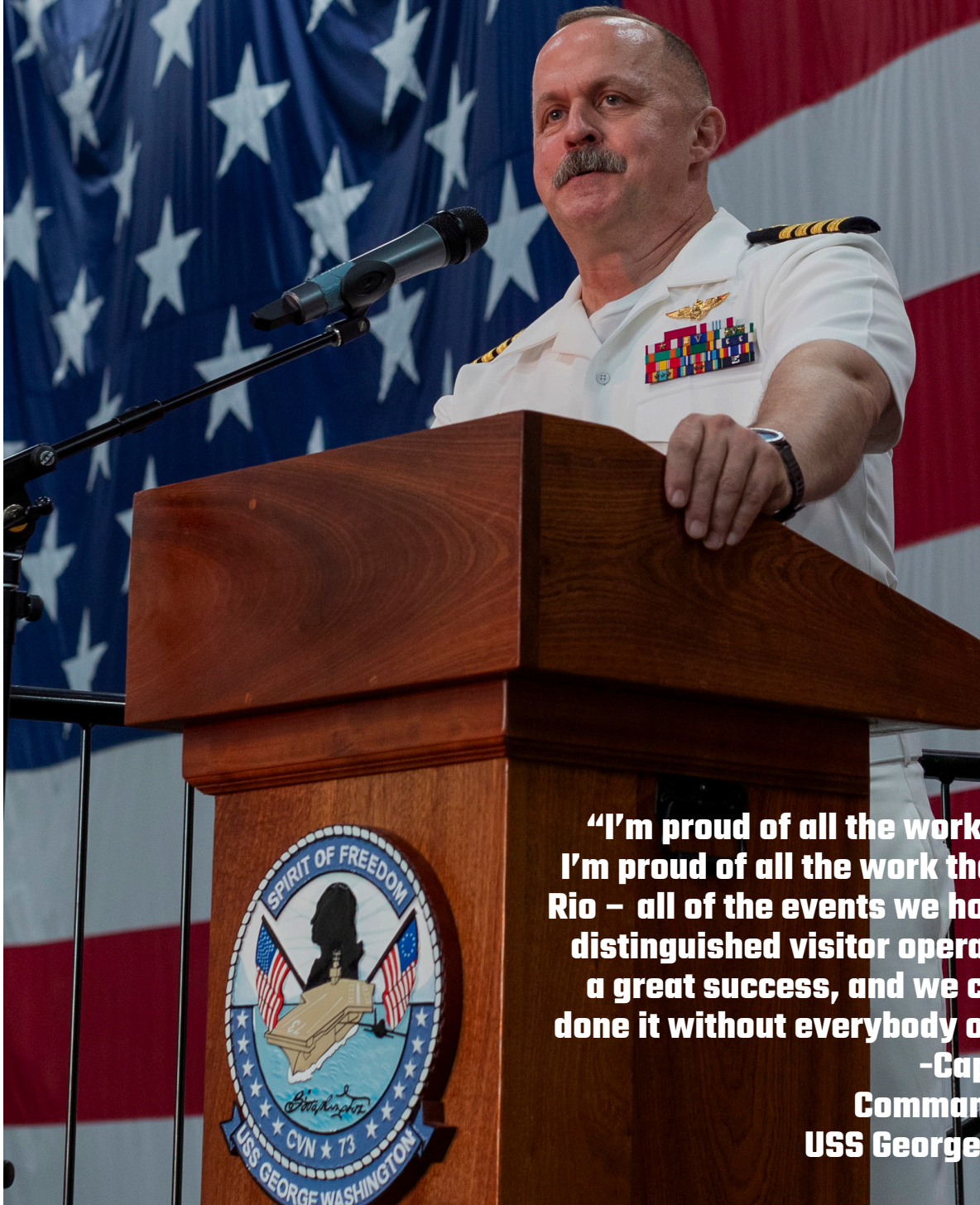

Port Visit: Rio de Janeiro

The George Washington Strike Group departed Rio de Janeiro after a scheduled port visit May 24. Rio de Janeiro was the first international port visit of the Southern Seas 2024 deployment.

While anchored off the coast of Rio de Janeiro, USS George Washington (CVN 73) hosted a formal diplomatic reception in the ship's hangar bay. In attendance were Ambassador Elizabeth F. Bagley, United States ambassador to Brazil, Gen. Laura J. Richardson, commander, U.S. Southern Command, and Adm. Renato Freire, chief of defense Armed Forces of Brazil, along with other local community leaders and distinguished guests.

During the reception, Bagley and Richardson both spoke on the longstanding relationship between Brazil and United States.

"You are here because you represent the best of Brazil and the friendship between our two nations," said Bagley. "This year we celebrate our bicentennial – 200 years that made a profound impact on both of our countries."

Bagley also highlighted the significance of the Southern Seas 2024 deployment and the overall mission to strengthen bilateral partnerships and encourage interoperability among countries in the 4th Fleet area of responsibility.

"Like-minded democracies and the

relationship that Brazil and the United States have is very important," said Richardson. "The relationships and friendships that we've built over time have outlasted all of the commanders here."

Over 300 guests attended the reception, and the central band of the Brazilian Marine Corps performed throughout the evening. Sailors assigned to George Washington prepared and served refreshments. Guests toured the ship's hangar bay and flight deck which offered a scenic view of Rio de Janeiro.

George Washington's Morale, Welfare, and Recreation program offered a variety of tours and activities for Sailors in the area during the four-day visit. The tours included Sugarloaf Mountain, Christ the Redeemer – one of the Seven Wonders of the World – and other local attractions.

"It was quite an experience to see sites of Rio," said Airman Sydney A. Paiz, from Las Vegas. "Getting the chance to see places like Christ the Redeemer and Sugarloaf Mountain was just an amazing experience."

George Washington, is deployed as part of Southern Seas 2024 which seeks to enhance capability, improve interoperability, and strengthen maritime partnerships with countries throughout the U.S. Southern Command area of responsibility through joint, multinational, and interagency exchanges and cooperation.

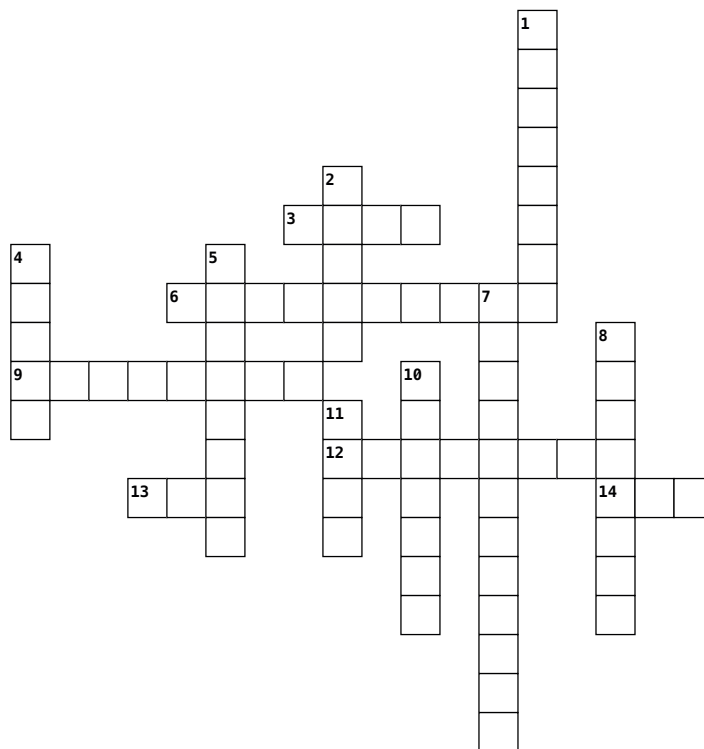

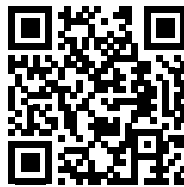
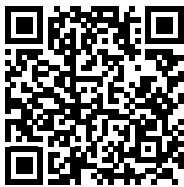
