

NAVY FAMILY OMBUDSMAN PROGRAM



Ombudsmen are official, appointed, liaisons between commanding officers and families. They can expedite communication between the command and families. In addition, Ombudsmen provide information on services, upcoming events, and/or help in crisis situations. Air Force Key Spouses & Family Readiness Assistants are similar to Ombudsmen, support service members, their families, and command leadership. CREDO: Springs of Life - Candles

The holidays are here. There will be many festive occasions to celebrate the holidays which occur in December. Holiday is a shortened version of holy day. Holy days call for us to reflect on our lives; on what we have done well and on what we have not done so well. In the things we have not done so well, the holidays remind us once again there is hope for renewal and change.

The Jewish festival Hanukkah begins this year on Dec. 26. The word "Hanukkah" means 'dedication" and is also referred to as "The Festival of Lights." Among other things, the celebration commemorates an event in biblical times when an oil lamp that only had enough oil in it for one night burned for eight days. On each one of the eight days, one candle is added to a special candle holder called a "menorah." The middle candle, called the "shamash," is used to light each of the other candles and it is lit every night. Therefore, on the first night of Hanukkah, two candles are lit and on the last night, there are nine lit candles.

Christmas occurs on Dec. 25. The word Christmas is a shortened version of Christ Mass. Christmas is the celebration of the birth of Jesus and its celebration starts on the first day of advent on the Christian church calendar. There are four days of advent before Christmas day. Each day of advent is represented by a candle. These candles represent Hope, Peace, Joy, and Love. One candle is lit before the Christian service on each day of advent.

Kwanzaa is a 7-day festival celebrating the African-American people, their culture and their history. It is a time of celebration, community gathering and reflection. Kwanzaa begins on Dec. 26 and continues until New Year's Day, Jan. 1. Each evening, a family member, usually the youngest child, lights the candles in a special candle holder and the family discusses one of the seven principles of Kwanzaa. The first candle symbolizes unity; the second selfdetermination; the third symbolizes collective work and responsibility; the fourth symbolizes cooperative economics; the fifth is for purpose; the sixth symbolizes creativity and the seventh is for faith.

It's interesting that in each of these celebrations candles are used. Though unique in their history and reasons why they are celebrated, each one calls to remembrance events of the past with a hope that tomorrow will bring more meaningful and enriching lives. In the darkness of frustration, despair and broken relationships, the candles light the way to hope, tranquility and wholeness. The lit candle reassures every heart that the possibility for change is within reach for all of us. The journey begins as we reach out to others in a genuine effort to bring hope and peace in their lives. Only when we reach out and think of otherness during these holy days will we have enough light for our journey. There is a brighter day ahead!

So, my daughter and I would invite her honorary grandmother, Ms. Donna, over. She would bring a dish, and we would all eat together, just the three of us. Afterwards she would help take down the fall decorations and put up the Christmas ones. That became our new tradition while in Yokosuka.

At your next duty station, your holiday is bound to look different. New friends and maybe old ones will be there to spend the seasons with. New traditions and culture can be added ingredients to the melting pot of how we celebrate. 


