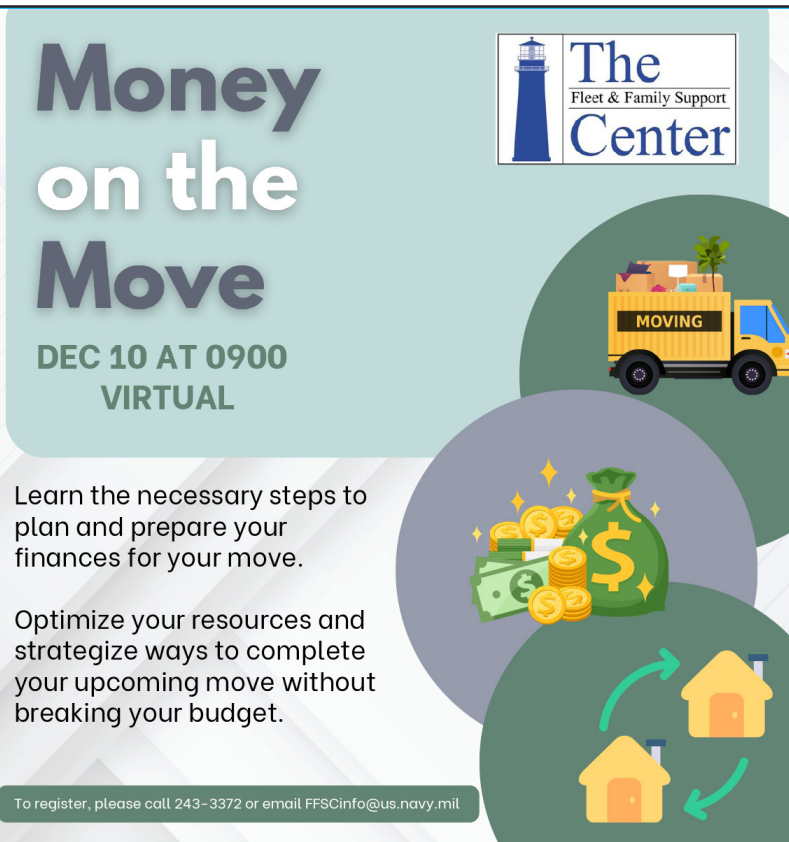

Hasedera Fall Illuminations Until Dec. 8 (Sunday)

From sunset to 7:30 p.m. (Entry, 7 p.m.) | Hasedera (6-minute walk from Enoden Hase Station, EN-12/30-minute walk from JR Kamakura Station, JO-07)
Hasedera's lights will illuminate the canopy of autumn leaves from sunset each day. Wander under the boughs, through the traditional structures, and around the ponds.



Hagoita Ichi (Market) Dec. 17 (Tuesday) - 19 (Thursday)

10 a.m. to 9 p.m. | Sensouji (6-minute walk from Toei Asakusa Station, A-18/Tokyo Metro Asakusa Station, G-19)
Sensouji and the surrounding area famous for the selling of hagoita, a rectangular board used to play "hanetsuki". Many of the hagoita for sale at the fair are elaborately decorated with famous Japanese musicians, kabuki stars, athletes of the year and celebrities, and meant to be used as ornaments.

Philippine Festival Dec. 7 (Saturday) - 8 (Sunday)

9 a.m. to 8 p.m. | Yoyogi Park Event Square (10-minute walk from JR Harajyuku Station, JY-19)

This Philippines Embassy-supported festival is Japan's biggest Philippines event and will feature domestic entertainers as well as those flown in from the Philippines. There will be fashion shows, traditional dancing, a dance contest, cosplay, and traditional Filipino food booths.

PREPARE TODAY! COMPLETE A RED CROSS CONTACT CARD

One of the main Red Cross missions OCONUS is to provide the Emergency Communication Message, AKA "Red Cross Message". If you or an immediate family member experience an emergency that requires you to request leave from your Command, the Red Cross can verify that emergency as a third party. We will then deliver that information to

your command, enabling them to make an informed decision regarding your emergency leave. Fill out a contact card today to ensure your contact information is ready before an emergency arises. Filling out a card in advance helps you and your family save time in a crisis.

CONSTRUCTION AND CLOSURES

Yokosuka:

- Gridley Tunnel. Full closure for vehicles from Dec. 7 to 27. Construction of new high-voltage lines to support new Host-Nation constructed community facilities. Vehicle detours to/from housing area include 1st Ave, 3rd Ave and 4th Ave. Bikes and pedestrians are OK after Dec. 7
- Carney Gate. Full gate closure from 8 to 10 p.m. on Dec. 16. due to maintenance. Pedestrian traffic will not be affected.
- NEX building H-20 parking lot to be repaved (Jan. 27-31, 2025)
- Gravel lot across from berth 9 Blue Ridge to be repaired (Feb. 2-21, 2025)
- The parking lot immediately in front of ATG is secured through 2027 in support of the NSST Shiphandling Trainer construction. Additionally, half of the 12-hour parking lot is also secured to support NSST construction material laydown and management.
- 50 percent of Defense Logistics Agency parking lot secured until February 2025.
- McCormick Street and Leahy Street. Full road closure for underground utility works until Feb. 28, 2025.
- Vandegrift Lane: Full road closure until October 2025.

Ikego:

- A Government of Japan Contractor will perform excavation work on Shisagi Street from Dec. 9 to Aug. 31, 2025. Working hours will be between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m., Monday through Friday. Excavation site will be controlled as one-way alternating traffic control road during the daytime work. After daily working hours, road should be re-opened.
- 50 percent of Ikego NEX/MWR Parking Lot secured until the end of February 2025.
