





NCTC Trauma Management

From 10 to 11 DEC, 2024, twenty-four local, state and federal officers attended NCTC's military led Trauma Management course. Officers were instructed on tactical medical skills and techniques. The class included didactic, hands-on and scenario-based training.

On 9 JAN 2025, Trauma Management student, Lt. Jason Troutman of the Pennsylvania State Police, responded to an EMS call for an unresponsive 47-year-old female. Lt. Troutman was first on scene and provided medical care learned in his recent Trauma Mangement course. The patient was believed to be choking. Lt. Troutman inserted a nasopharyngeal airway, began CPR, dislodged the foreign object, and restored a pulse and spontaneous respirations. The patient was then transported to the local hospital and survived due to his efforts.
