2025 Road Tax Season

Effective June 1, all Vehicles **MUST** display the 2025 (Reiwa 7) USFJ Decal. Displaying 2024 decals after June 1 will result in denial of access and possible impoundment. Pay the Japanese road tax to receive your new decal(s).

One Stop Shop

When?

- March 17, 18 and April 10, 11 from 9 to 11:45 a.m./1 to 3:15 p.m. and for 100, 300 through 529 plates only. Pay Road Tax and get USFJ decal at Fleet Theater.
- This event is **NOT** for yellow plate car and motorcycle. Road Tax for yellow plate cars and motorcycles must be paid off base at Yokosuka City Hall starting April 1
- If you have a yellow plate car or motorcycle as an additional vehicle, you must wait until April 1 to receive decals.
- If you miss the events, pay your Road Tax at the Kanagawa Tax Office for normal and large vehicles, or pay your Road Tax at the Yokosuka City Hall for mini cars and motorcycles 125cc and above. Bring your documents to receive decal at VRO.

What to bring to pay road tax?

- 2024 Road Tax Receipt (last years)
- Japanese Vehicle Title
- Applicable Fees in YEN
- **2023 USFJ Decal is required by June 1, 2023.**

What to bring to get decal?

- ID Card
- 2025 road tax receipt

- Japanese Vehicle Title
- Base Inspection Sheet (if applicable)
- JCI Insurance
- Liability Insurance
- Parking Certificate with current residence (must be re-registered at LTO with the current address)
- Valid Drivers license (if you own more than one vehicle, bring all additional driver's license)
- Other than Spouse are required a Power of Attorney (POA)

How much am I going to pay?

- Mini Car (Yellow plate): ¥3,000
- Motorcycle, 126cc and above: ¥1,000
- 125cc and above: ¥500
- 400/500/501/529: ¥7,500
- Y300/301/329 (Less than 4.5L): ¥19,000
- 300/301/329 (More than 4.5L): ¥22,000
- 100: ¥32,000
- **CASH ONLY FOR PAYMENT (Yen)**

Notes: Representatives other than Spouse are required to present a Power of Attorney (POA) to receive decals. If member owns more than one vehicle, all vehicles **MUST** be registered at the **SAME TIME** to receive decals.

HOW IT WORKS

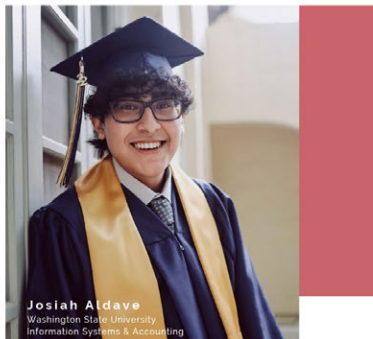
- Apply during open window

ELIGIBILITY

Spouses & children of active duty, retired or deceased Sailors & Marines may apply. Children must be DEERS eligible & under age 23 by September 30, 2025. Surviving dependents are eligible if the service member passed on active duty or once retired. Active Duty on MECEP or MECP orders are eligible for loans only.

AREAS OF STUDY

NMCRS Scholars may use funds for full or part-time programs working toward career & technical programs, associate's or bachelor's degrees. Spouses are eligible while completing first undergraduate or master's degree.

2025 TIMELINE

March 10 - May 15

Open window to create student NMCRS account, upload qualifying documents & complete application.

Late June 2025

Award announcements sent to all applicants via email and decisions also available on NMCRS account.

Early July 2025

Scholarship and loan acceptance deadline.

Late July 2025

Funds dispersed to Scholar's schools.

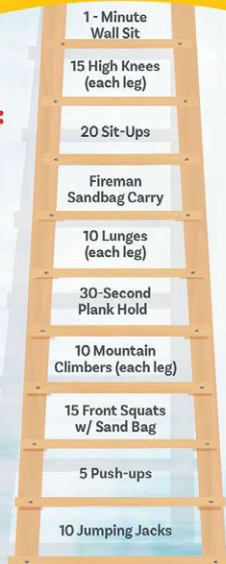
WORKOUT CHALLENGE

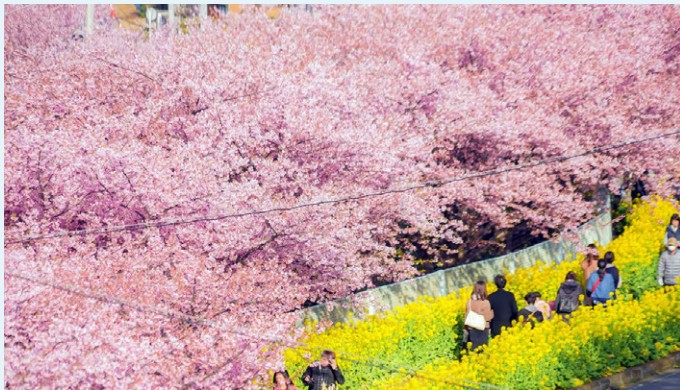


Nostalgic Car Festa in Yokosuka

OFF BASE TRAFFIC CONTROL

The roads between Yokosuka City Hall Kitashitaura Branch and Kurihama Pier will be controlled from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m. on Sunday, March 16 due to Kitashitaura Hometown Marathon.

CONSTRUCTION AND CLOSURES

Yokosuka: Due to maintenance, vehicular traffic at Carney Gate will be secured from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m., March 7. Pedestrian traffic will not be affected.

- Vandegrift Lane: Full road closure until October 2025.

- The parking lot immediately in front of ATG is secured through 2027 in support of the NSST Shiphandling Trainer construction. Additionally, half of the 12-hour parking lot is also secured to support NSST construction material laydown and management.

- Vandegrift Lane: Full road closure until October 2025.

Ikego: Shisagi Street partial closure. 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. until March 7. Install communications conduit. Partial road closure of Shisagi Street, full closure of adjacent parking spaces.

- A Government of Japan Contractor will perform excavation work on Shisagi Street until Aug. 31, 2025. Working hours will be between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m., Monday through Friday. Excavation site will be controlled as one-way alternating traffic control road during the daytime work. After daily working hours, road should be re-opened.

- 50 percent of Ikego NEX/MWR Parking Lot secured until the end of February 2025.
