## Harshaw FUSRAP Site Remedial Action Cleveland, Ohio

- From 1944 to 1959, various forms of uranium were processed at the site and sent to Oak Ridge, Tennessee for processing for the early atomic weapons program.
- In December 2023, USACE awarded a \$13.4 million contract for remedial action of Operable Units (OU)-1 North, OU-1 South, and OU-2.
- In June 2024, contractors began cleanup activities and installed air monitors that will remain in place until work is completed in 2025.

## Remediation Work Completed to Date:

- OU-2 1,405 cy (in situ) x 1.2 = **1,686 cy** (ex situ)
- OU-1S 5,423 cy (in situ) x 1.2 = 5,724 cy (ex situ)
- OU-1N 1,042 cy (in situ) x 1.2 = **2,565 cy** (ex situ)
- Total cubic yards to date 9,975 (ex situ)
- **8,018** tons of soil & **1,740** tons of concrete transported for disposal.
