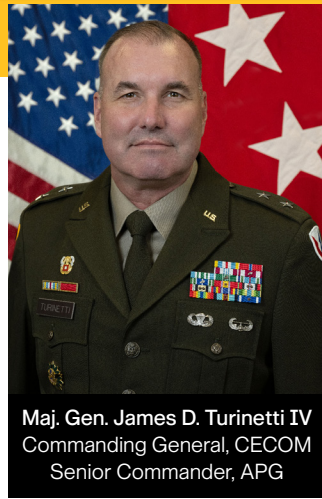

LEADERSHIP RECAP

CECOM continues to drive modernization and operational readiness through key technological breakthroughs. During Operation Jailbreak, ASIC built the Army's first-ever API marketplace in 24 hours to enable combat software data sharing and cut deployment times. TYAD is responding to Army needs by launching brushless motor assembly lines to produce 500,000 motors annually. Meanwhile, CECOM serves as a key partner in shaping the new Army Data Operations Center pilot program. Leadership championed our latest efforts to the Army's Principal Cyber Advisor and at the House Depot Caucus, highlighting installation resiliency and microelectronics.

To sustain this progress internally, we launched the CECOM Transformation Think Tank, a cohort that leverages the expertise of junior personnel and pairs them with senior mentors. We also welcomed CSM Andrew DeCola to the AMLC. Building on recent town hall updates regarding artificial intelligence, PACOM, and the Maxiflex schedule, the newly announced CECOM Broadcast launches July 8 to expand command-wide news globally. This steady progress drives our continuous transformation heading into July.
