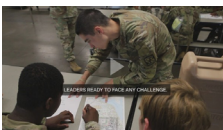
Blue Grass Chemical Activity cases colors after historic zero-fail mission

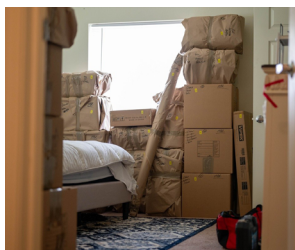
