The mission of Navy Closure Task Force-Red Hill (NCTF-RH) is to execute the permanent decommissioning of the Red Hill Bulk Fuel Storage Facility (RHBFSF) safely and expeditiously, and continue long-term environmental remediation in coordination with State and Federal regulators in order to protect public health and the environment.



NCTF-RH Continues Expanding Groundwater Monitoring Well Network

Navy Closure Task Force-Red Hill continues to expand its extensive groundwater monitoring network in and around the Red Hill Bulk Fuel Storage Facility (RHBFSF). The team is installing its 49th groundwater monitoring well along the H3 freeway.

The location was strategically selected to provide water quality information as well as geological data in a key area to the northwest of the RHBFSF, where no monitoring wells previously existed. Groundwater monitoring well locations are selected in collaboration with regulators and stakeholders and permitted through appropriate state authorities.
