Operation Patriot Press is an annual, enterprise-wide logistics and sustainment training operation led by U.S. Army Materiel Command and executed by U.S. Army Sustainment Command. OPP immerses Soldiers in real world munitions, distribution, and sustainment missions across the Organic Industrial Base. The exercise places units directly into live operational environments where they perform tasks that support the Army's strategic sustainment mission and strengthens the Army's ability to execute large scale sustainment operations by integrating Active, National Guard, Army Reserve, and Civilian personnel into a unified logistics enterprise.
