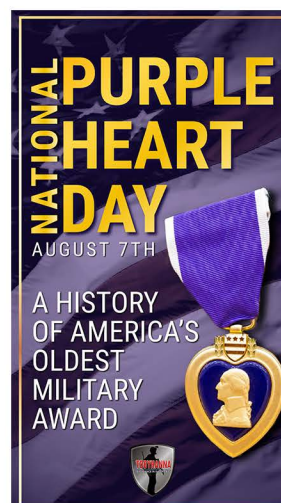
RED HORSE Squadron Gallops into Action

The squadron's current focus is renovating the parking lot at The Landing, a project that will enhance safety and upgrade the overall quality of life on post.

TYAD's newest Safety Star Point of the Quarter is Nick Gerardi of the Directorate of Mission Execution's Shelter Harness Branch. Gerardi earned the honor for his instrumental assistance with implementing safe work practices and personal protective equipment within the work area.
