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TYAD motors power drone to world-record flight

REDSTONE ARSENAL, Ala. – During the Game of Drones demonstration at Edwards Air Force Base, California, July 15-17, two brushless direct current motors assembled at Tobyhanna Army Depot successfully powered a small UAS to a record-breaking flight time of eight hours, 41 minutes and 43 seconds. The aircraft flew for approximately 300 miles before safely landing, surpassing the previous record by 50 minutes.



6 new initiatives reduce inventory burdens
