Warfighter-Tested: Tobyhanna's Latest Innovation Proves Successful During Test

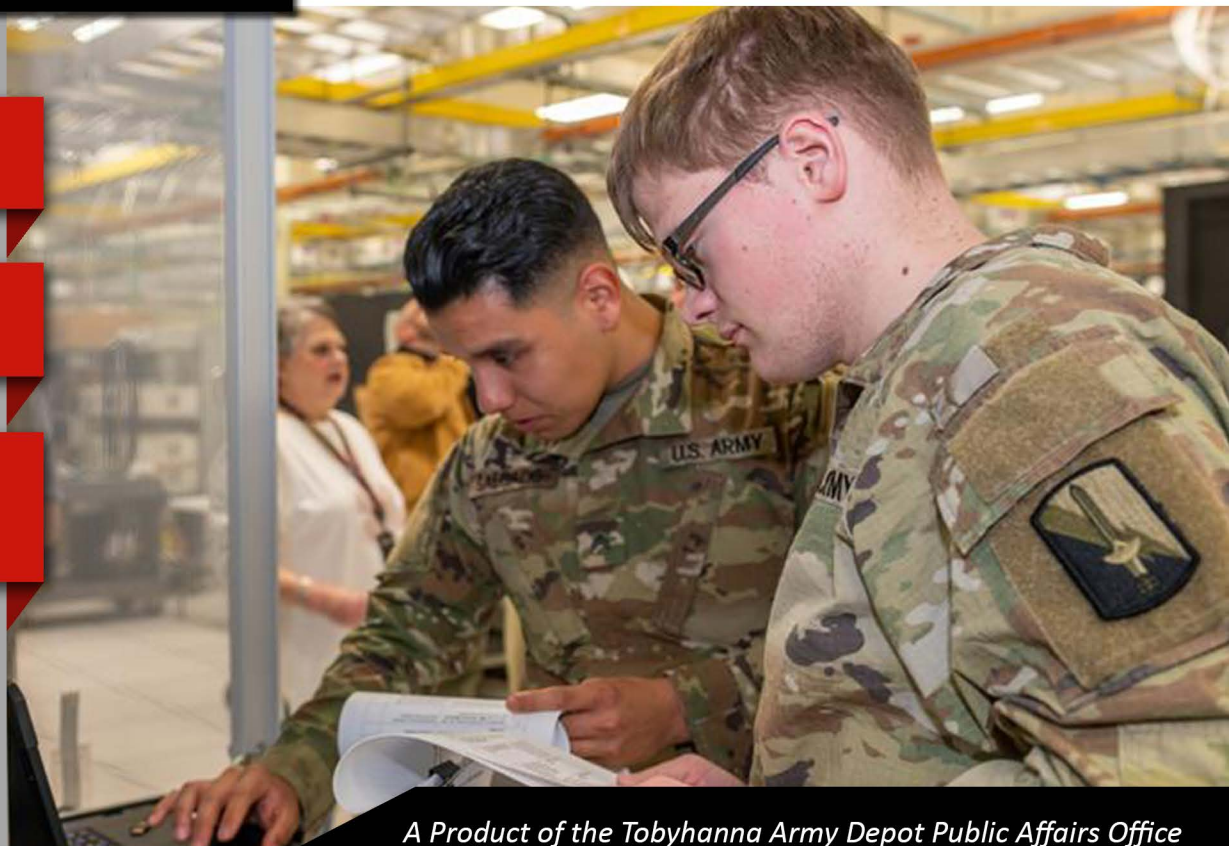

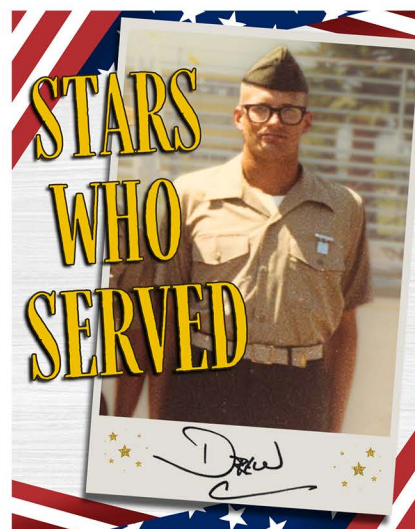
Stars Who Served - Drew Carey

During his youth, Carey battled depression, survived two suicide attempts, and faced academic expulsion. Seeking a purpose in life, he enlisted in the United States Marine Corps Reserve. Carey served for six years as a field radio operator in the 25th Marine Regiment.

"Being a Marine taught me how to work hard...and how to make the best out of every situation," he said.

After winning an open mic contest, his career steadily rose, appearing on several TV shows. Fast
