BAE SYSTEMS ORDNANCE SYSTEMS INC. (OSI) RADFORD ARMY AMMUNITION PLANT

AUGUST 31, 2026

The Radford Army Ammunition Plant (RFAAP) in Radford, Virginia is a government-owned, contractor-operated (GOCO) military industrial installation under the jurisdiction of the United States Army. BAE Systems Ordnance Systems Inc. (OSI) is the operating contractor for RFAAP. The primary mission of the RFAAP as a munitions propellant manufacturing facility is to supply solvent and solventless propellant to the United States Armed Forces. As part of this mission, RFAAP operates two hazardous waste incinerators, referred to as Incinerators 440 and 441, to destroy off specification or production waste propellant mixtures.

On October 12, 2005, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) promulgated the Phase I Final Replacement National Emissions Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants for Hazardous Waste Combustors (HWC NESHAP) under joint authority of the Clean Air Act Amendments of 1990 (CAAA) and the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA). Also known as Maximum Achievable Control Technology (MACT) standards, the HWC NESHAP sets stringent emissions limits for incinerators that burn hazardous waste.

As required by the HWC NESHAP, incinerators must conduct a Comprehensive Performance Test (CPT) to demonstrate compliance with the emission standards. Facilities must make the site-specific comprehensive performance test and the continuous monitoring systems performance evaluation test plans that describe this testing event available to the public for review. This public notice is being mailed to all persons listed on the RFAAP Facility Mailing List.

The test is scheduled to begin on November 2, 2026, and should be completed by November 6, 2026. A copy of the referenced test plan is available for viewing from September 1st until November 2nd, 2026, at:
