## 25 Years Later: Tobyhanna takes steps to remember Sept. 11

Marking a quarter-century since Sept. 11, 2001, the Tobyhanna Army Depot workforce paused on Sept. 9 to honor the 2,977 innocent lives lost and remember the sacrifices of our nation's first responders. The commemorative event started with a walk that honored the 2,200 steps first responders took that fateful day and was followed by remarks from Michael J. Milner, a retired Fire Department of the City of New York (FDNY) firefighter who responded to the World Trade Center.

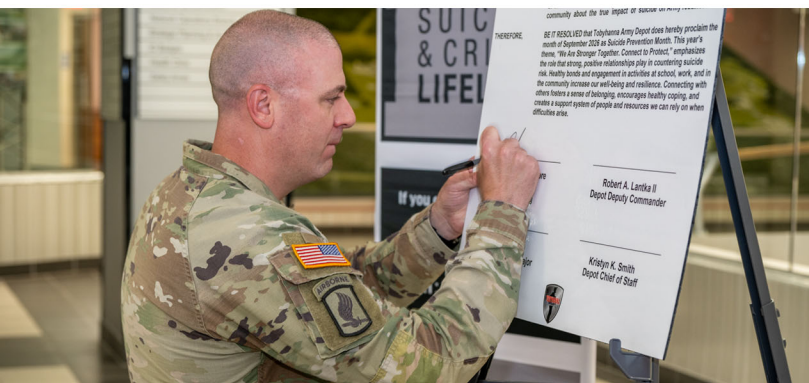
## ■ Farewell to Maj. Gen. James D. Turinetti IV
